

Saint Mary's University of Bayombong (SMU) strives to offer accessible quality education that transforms students into persons of conscience, competence, and compassion. Its vision is to become "a premier CICM Catholic educational institution drawn into communion by the Wisdom of God, dedicated to the integral formation of persons exemplifying excellence, innovation, and passion for Christ's mission."

Huachiew Chalermprakiet University (HCU) is a university of international level academic excellence founded by the Poh Tek Sieng Tung Overseas Chinese Foundation in Thailand, adhering to six values of diligence, perseverance, frugality, compassion, honesty, and filial piety, with the goal of "studying, to be of service to society."

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) is designed to foster a mutually beneficial relationship through cooperation in teaching and research between HCU and SMU, hereinafter jointly referred to as "The Parties." Accordingly, no financial obligations are assumed under this Understanding.



The Parties have reached an understanding on the following areas of cooperation, subject to mutual consent and the availability of sufficient funding:

- Annual joint research conference
- Research and preservation of language and cultural roots
- · Benchmarking on quality assurance and character formation
- · Joint research activities and exchange of faculty
- Exchange of academic materials and other information
- Short-term academic programs
- Student exchange for research and study

The terms of such mutual assistance and funding for any specific program and activity shall be mutually discussed, agreed upon in writing, and duly executed by both parties prior to the initiation of a particular program.

Each institution will designate an individual to coordinate this program and all endeavors that may derive from it. For this purpose, SMU designates **Dr. Clara M. Gonzales**, the Head of its Promotions, External Relations, and Internationalization Office. On the other hand, HCU designates **Ms. Yinyun Wei**, being its Head of the International Relations Office.

No amendment, consent, or waiver of terms of this MOU shall bind either party unless in writing and signed by all parties. Any such amendment, consent, or waiver shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specified purpose given. The parties to this MOU, by the signatures below of their authorized representatives, acknowledge having read and understood this MOU and agree to be bound by its terms and conditions.

This MOU shall commence on the date of the latest signature and be in effect for five (5) years, at which time it shall be reviewed for possible extension. Either party may terminate this MOU by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the institution initiating the notice for cause/s provided by law. However, such notification must be received by the other party at least six (6) months prior to the effective date of termination.

This MOU will become the basis for more specific areas of cooperation and collaboration, which will be formally agreed to, and become addenda to this Understanding.
