WHEREAS, the **SECOND PARTY** agrees to this proposal of the **FIRST PARTY** subject to its policies, procedures and guidelines governing affiliation and training of students in the Department and Other Health Agencies, and the provisions in the CHED-DOH JMC No 2021-001 entitled: "Guidelines in the Gradual Reopening of Campuses of Higher Education Institutions for Limited Face-to-Face Classes during the Covid-19 Pandemic", Annex "J".

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Section 2. Obligation of the Second Party:

a. To make available its staff and facilities in the training of the Nursing students of the FIRST PARTY;

b. To determine the Clinical areas and other assignments of the FIRST PARTY'S students during the course of their training, this shall include the duration of the training in each clinical section. This shall also include proper decorum and their working relationships with all the personnel of the institution.

ARTICLE II - COMMON PROVISIONS

For nursing students: BSN 2-___, BSN 3-___ and BSN 4-___ for one semester.

For Midwifery students:

SECTION 4: The FIRST PARTY will settle the following fees prior to the scheduled rotation:



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

PREAMBLE

Taking into consideration that it is in the best interest of both parties to establish, strengthen and formalise their collaboration;

Recognising the mutual benefits arising from this Memorandum of Understanding;

Agree to co-operate:

1. PARTIES

The parties to this Memorandum are:

VIVES UNIVERSITY OF APPLIED SCIENCES, situated at Doorniksesteenweg 145, 8500 Kortrijk and Xaverianenstraat 10, 8200 Brugge, Belgium Legal representative in his Official Capacity: Mr. Joris Hindryckx (president) Contact person: Mrs. Tine Ternest (Head International Office VIVES) —

(hereafter referred to as "VIVES")

and

SAINT MARY'S UNIVERSITY, a CICM Educational Institution with principal office at Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya, Philippines.

(hereafter referred to as "SMU")

(the parties referred to in clauses 1.1 and 1.2 hereinafter collectively referred to as "the parties").

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

2. SCOPE OF COOPERATION

2.1. This Memorandum seeks to establish the framework for cooperation between VIVES and SMU and serves as an umbrella agreement by which any other agreement regarding specific cooperation projects or programs to be signed between VIVES and SMU shall be governed and interpreted.

The parties will carry on a continued programme of exchanging information on a wide variety of educational and applied research programmes involving all faculties concerned, such as:

Education

The information exchange will not be limited to the educational contacts only. Other contacts, such as with enterprises, service centres, community centres, hospitals, industry shall be encouraged.

- 2.2. The parties agree to pursue the following forms of cooperation, within areas that are mutually acceptable, such as:
- a) Exchange of undergraduate students for study or/and placement;
- b) Exchange of teaching and or academic staff;
- c) Cooperative applied research and development activities;
- d) Collaborative teaching activities, joint degree programs, conferences/symposia;
- e) Participation in curriculum review or development and exchange of academic materials;
- f) Benchmarking; and
- g) Any other mutually agreed activity that would benefit both parties.

Any projects will be subject to mutual consent, availability of resources and approval of the parties.

2.3. All proposed projects including anything contemplated under 2.2 will be implemented into a more detailed binding agreement of collaboration, a "Specific Agreement", as an annex supplemental to this Memorandum, after they have been agreed upon and duly authorized by the official representatives of VIVES and SMU.



Each Specific Agreement will describe the details necessary to implement any joint project, such as but not limited to:

- a) The activities associated with the project;
- b) The responsibility of each of the parties;
- c) The budget for each activity;
- d) The sources of funding;
- e) Personal involved;
- f) Installations and equipment to be used;
- g) Work schedules;
- h) All other specific terms and conditions necessary to achieve the specified objectives of the project.

3. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The parties agree to define and manage questions related to intellectual property, such as ownership of industrial rights patents, certificates of invention, registry of models, and copyright of written materials, that may result from cooperative research, through the corresponding Specific Agreement.

The parties recognize that it may be necessary for each to transfer to the other information of a proprietary nature. Proprietary information shall be clearly identified by the disclosing party as proprietary at the time of the written disclosure. Oral disclosers shall be reduced to writing and marked as "proprietary" and provided to the other party within 30 days of such oral disclosure. The parties shall keep confidential any information of such nature, subject to compliance with the domestic laws of the parties. The parties are permitted to exchange proprietary information during the five-year term of this Memorandum. Nondisclosure obligations shall expire five years after the effective date of this Memorandum.

The term "Intellectual Property" means individually and collectively all inventions, improvements and/or discoveries, patentable or unpatentable, copyrightable or uncopyrightable, including but not limited to mask works, computer software, both object and source code, data bases and works of authorship.

4. MARKETING AND PUBLICITY

Neither of the Parties shall use the name, symbols, branding or marks of the other Party in any publicity, advertising or announcement, without the other Party's prior written approval.

5. CONFIDENTIALITY

The Parties undertake not to directly or indirectly, utilise, disclose or make public any confidential Information relating to the other party.



6. ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENTS

All cooperative activities associated with courses and programs must be consistent with the accreditation requirements of both institutions. Consistency with accreditation principles will be included in all Specific Agreements associated with the implementation of courses and programs. This Memorandum of Understanding does not imply the extension of accreditation from one institution to the other.

7. LEGAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS

Any student and/or staff member/academic personnel associated with this Memorandum must comply with all the legal and administrative requirements, including immigration, insurance and other applicable requirements, of the home and host institutions. Any exchanges involving the above must be established through a separate Specific Agreement.

The parties further agree to comply with all applicable national and international laws.

All commitments, obligations, and expenditures related to projects approved under this Memorandum shall be administered in accordance with each institution's normal practices and policies and the specific terms and conditions of the funding regulations.

8. FINANCIAL CONSEQUENSES

The parties may, jointly or separately, endeavor to obtain financial resources from other institutions, government agencies and national and international organizations for the development of activities associated with the implementation of any Specific Agreement.

Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will be mutually discussed and agreed in writing and signed by the two parties prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity.

9. PUBLICATION OF RESEARCH

Any research generated in conjunction herewith (as further described in a Specific Agreement) shall be subject to unrestricted publication or dissemination, provided that (a) each party requires a copy of any proposed publication sixty days in advance of submission to review for a party's property information, patent and/or other intellectual property rights; (b) each party's proprietary information, patents and/or other intellectual property rights shall be protected by allowing the party who owns such rights to review the proposed publication prior to submission by the other party and the party who owns such rights will complete its review and make any objections within sixty days of receipt of the proposed publication; (c) such publication or dissemination will not compromise patent rights and/or other intellectual property rights, or inadvertently divulge proprietary information.



10. REPRESENTATIVES

In recognition of the fact that meaningful programmes of the type envisioned in this Memorandum of Understanding require constant planning and attention, each Institution will appoint at least two representatives to serve as a Planning Committee which will concern itself with the following functions:

- Maintaining continuous communication on the ways and means by which such a relationship
 can be most fruitful for all concerned.
- Constant exploration of ways and means to finance joint projects in an effort to avoid delays in programmes for want of necessary financial support.

11. DURATION, RENEWAL, AMENDMENT AND TERMINATION

This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective on the date that it is signed by all parties and shall be valid for a period of **5 years** therefrom. It can be renewed for an additional period of **5** years by written agreement of both parties.

Cancellation of this Memorandum prior to the expiration of the 5 years period as provided above may be effected by either party with a notification of six months in advance of the anticipated date of termination.

Termination shall not affect the implementation of activities that have already commenced pursuant to a Specific Agreement. Those Specific Agreements will remain in effect until the required associated activities are completed.

No variation or consensual termination of this Memorandum of Agreement or any part thereof shall be of any force or effect unless in writing and signed by or on behalf of the Parties.

12. DISPUTE RESOLUTION AND LEGAL STATUS

The parties have agreed to enter into this Memorandum in order to record their wish to explore the potential for further co-operation. For the avoidance of doubt, this document is not legally binding and shall not commit the parties to a sole or exclusive relationship; to any legal liability or obligation or to the incurring of any expenditure.

This Memorandum shall not prevent either institute from establishing similar relations with other institutions in the same or in other countries.

The contradicting stances, perspectives, and interpretations of this Memorandum shall be settled amicably through sound consultation and negotiation among the parties.

Every litigation related to the understanding of one part of this Memorandum and which could not be agreeably discoursed between the parties shall be finally settled under the CEPANI Rules of Arbitration by one or more arbitrators appointed in accordance with the said Rules. The



arbitration shall be conducted in English. The parties expressly exclude any application for setting aside the arbitral award.

More so, the parties shall agree that no person will be discriminated on any grounds whatsoever, from participation under the terms articulated in this Memorandum.

By signing this document, the parties acknowledge that they have reviewed and understood the content and extent of each of its clauses and agree to carry out the actions necessary to implement it. Two copies of this document will be signed in English and both versions with the same content and validity.
